Market Commentary

STRONG CURRENCY PUSHES PRICES DOWN

PORT ELIZABETH: The sharp increase in the value of the rand negatively affected this week's wool sale and Cape Wools' market indicator dropped 6,4% to close at R24,25/kg (clean).

The appreciation was spurred on by a rampant gold price and dramatic gains in the euro, which saw the rand gaining 32c (5,2%) against the US dollar since the previous sale two weeks ago.

All micron categories were affected with prices of some long wool categories falling by as much as 8%. The downturn in the market also resulted in a higher than usual pass in rate. Only 71% of the 11 588 bales on offer was sold.

Major buyers were SA Wool Exporters (2 197 bales), Modiano (2 163 bales), Stucken (1 847 bales), Segard Masurel (816 bales), and Beier Finances (753 bales).

Average clean prices for good quality long (75 - 95mm) Merino fleeces (spinners' and good topmakers' styles) were as follows: there were no quotes for19 microns; 20 microns (7 lots) were down 7,8% at R35,95/kg; 21 microns (13 lots) shed 7,4% at R32,32/kg; 22 microns (8 lots) were 8% cheaper at R31,46/kg; 23 microns (10 lots) shed 6,4% at R30,97/kg, 24 microns (8 lots) were down 4,8% at R29.92/kg, and 25 microns (2 lots) dropped 3,1% at R29,55/kg.


The next sale has been rostered for 19 April when approximately 8 500 bales will be offered.
