Market Commentary

WOOL MARKET SOFTENS

Port Elizabeth - The Cape Wools Merino Indicator basket has been amended to more a ccurately reflect the basket of wool traded internationally. Given the impact of these changes an erratum to the communication of 28 January was issued. Market conditions remain challenging at this week's sale and the Cape Wools Merino Indicator shed 1,53% to close at R109.72 (clean). This is 1,7% lower compared to the opening sale and 8,7% below the corresponding sale of last year.

Local traders reported solid demand for good quality, fine Merino wool while coarser wool came under pressure. Inferior, poorly grown wool was less sought after and traded at values well below their better quality counterparts.

The rand appreciated by 0,2% against the US dollar compared with the average rate at the previous sale, trading at R11,55, while it was 2,1% stronger against the Euro at R13,10. The offering comprised of 11 993 bales of which 94% was sold. Major traders were Lempriere SA (4 007), Standard Wool SA (2 792), G Modiano SA (1 89 0) and Stucken & Co (1 445).

The average clean prices for the selection within the different categories good top-making (MF5), long fleeces were as follows: 18 microns were up by 6,9% to close at R126,15/kg, 18,5 microns stren gthened by 2,1% to R120,43/kg, 19 microns shed 1,6% to close at R114,90/kg, 19,5 microns dropped with 2,0% to close at R1 09,95/kg, 20 microns lost 1,4% to close at R108,01/kg, 20,5 microns decreased with 2,1% to close at R107,14/kg, 21 microns dec lined 2,3% to close at R105,70/kg, 21,5 microns weakened by 2,5% to R106,61/kg and 22 microns lost 0,8% to close at R106,79/kg.

The next sale is scheduled for 4 February where approximately 9 00 0 bales will be on offer.
