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Market Commentary

WOOL MARKET STABLE

PORT ELIZABETH: There was little change in this week's wool sale and Cape Wools' overall indicator closed a marginal 0,4% higher at R24,75/kg (clean).

The rand, which was 1,5% weaker against the US dollar compared with the previous sale, supported the market. As a result, the average prices for the various micron categories were mostly unchanged.

A total of 8 337 bales was offered of which 95% was sold. Major buyers were Modiano (3 179 bales), Stucken (1 222 bales), Chargeurs Wool (1 126 bales), SA Wool Exporters (830 bales) and United Wool (746 bales).

Average clean prices for good quality long (75 - 95mm) Merino fleeces (spinners' and good topmakers' styles) were as follows: 19 microns were 4% dearer at R39,23/kg, 20 microns were up 0,4% at R35,41/kg, 21 microns were unchanged at R33,05/kg, 22 microns were 0,3 cheaper at R32,24/kg, 23 microns were unchanged at R32,04/kg, 24 microns dropped 1,2% to R30,96/kg, and 25 microns were unchanged at R29,61/kg.


