## **Market Commentary**

## **Cape Wools Weekly Market Report**

Port Elizabeth - The wool market consolidated at this weeks sale with the Cape Wools Merino Indicator maintaining its recent rand gains with a slight decline of only 1.0% compared to the last sale to close the day at a value of R126.80 (Clean). On the Australian Market, the indicator gained 2.2%. The Cape Wools All Wool Indicator shed 1.1%.

Local traders commented that trade got off to a brisk start but eased as the day progressed with satisfactory demand from Chinese customers for this time of the year. The rand weakness supported the market on the day. The rand weakened by -4,4% against the US dollar compared with the average rate at the previous sale, trading at R13.44, while the Euro weakened -6,4%, trading at R15.14 The offering comprised of 8 838 bales of which 98.7% was sold. Major traders were Lempriere SA (2 508), G Modiano SA (2 496) Standard Wool SA (1 959), and Stucken & Co (949).

The average clean prices for the selection within the different categories good top-making (MF5), long fleeces were as follows: 18,5 microns weakened by -1.6% to R134,57/kg, 19 microns dropped -1.9% to close at R132,29/kg, 19,5 microns dropped with 0,8% to close at R130,15/kg, 20 microns declined with -0,6% to close at R128,10/kg, 20,5 microns decreased with -0.9% to close at R127,12/kg, 21,0 microns dropped -0.5% to close at R127,24/kg, 21,5 microns weakened by -1.8% to close at R124,15/kg and 22,0 microns dropped with ,-0.5% to close at R125,93/kg.

The next sale is scheduled for 9 September where approximately ±5 000 bales will be on offer.
