Market Commentary

WOOL MARKET INCREASE

Port Elizabeth - The wool market capitalized on its recent gains and increased significantly with the Cape Wools Merino Indicator gaining 5,3% on the previous sale to close at a value of R129,76 (Clean). On the Australian market, the indicator gained 4,2%. The Cape Wools All Wool Indicator strengthened with 4,9%.

Traders eagerly competed for the good selection of fine wools on offer and commented that it was a good market at present with decent demand experienced from both European and Asian buyers.

This week saw the rand at R13,64 to the US dollar. The rand weakened by 1,9% against the US dollar compared with the average rate at the previous sale, trading at R13,64 while the Rand gained 0,9% against the Euro, trading at R15.07. The offering comprised of 10 015 bales of which 97,7% was sold. Major traders were Standard Wool SA (3 010), G Modiano SA (2 951), Lempriere SA (2 408) and Stucken &Co (752).

The average clean prices for the selection within the different categories good top-making (MF5), long fleeces were as follows: 18,5 microns strengthened by 4,9% to R140,03/kg; 19 microns gained 6,6% to close at R137,20/kg; 19,5 microns gained 5,4% to close at R133,40/kg; 20 microns increased with 5,4% to close at R130,06/kg; 20,5 microns gained 5,5% to close at R128,35/kg; 21,0 microns gained 5,4% to close at R127,28/kg; 21,5 microns gained 4,4% to close at R126,03/kg and 22,0 microns increased with 3.6% to close at R124,91/kg.

The next sale is scheduled for 04 November where approximately ±10 440 bales will be on offer.
